May 6, 2017	<p>Can one organisation apply for more than one area from the different areas in the RFA.</p> <p>Which are the main Geographical Areas that the RFA is specifically interested in in Nairobi, since you will agree that there are organisations working in more than one sub county.</p>	<p>An organisation can apply for more than one RFA if they have capacity to implement different RFAs.</p> <p>Afya jijini may consider organisations which apply for a section of the defined scope of work in an RFA e.g. in Mentor mother RFA, an organisation that elects to apply to support facility based mentor mothers only, or Community based Mentor Mothers only may be considered, but this will be at the discretion of the grants selection committee. However, if for example in the same RFA, an organization chooses to apply for both components, that organization is allowed to submit only one proposal for that particular RFA</p> <p>Afya jijini works in all informal settlements in Nairobi except Kibera. However, for MHMC/HCBF and SASA RFAs, the focus is in Mukuru kwa Njenga but expected to expand to include some wards in Westlands sub-county.</p> <p>Organisation may apply to implement activities in the regions they have community presence in and not necessarily in all the regions in Nairobi.</p>
